



Apply for the Marion B. Sewer Distinguished Scholarship for Undergraduates

Marion B. Sewer, an accomplished pharmacology professor, was deeply committed to service within the scientific community. The Marion B. Sewer Distinguished Scholarship for Undergraduates offers tuition funding to students who demonstrate an interest in the fields of biochemistry and molecular biology and who enhance the diversity of science.

Scholarship benefits:

- \$2,000 toward tuition for one academic year.
- Recipients of the Marion B. Sewer Distinguished Scholarship for Undergraduates are eligible to apply for an additional scholarship in subsequent years.

Scholarship requirements:

To be considered, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national or permanent resident. Foreign nationals who are in the U.S. on a visa are not eligible.
- Be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited two- or four- year institution located in the U.S. or U.S. territories.
- Have completed a minimum of 60 credit hours (or equivalent).
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0-point scale.
- Have faced significant educational, social, cultural or economic barriers in pursuit of education.
- Be committed to diversity on campus and in the scientific community as a whole.
- Be an ASBMB member (membership can be processed at time of application).
